

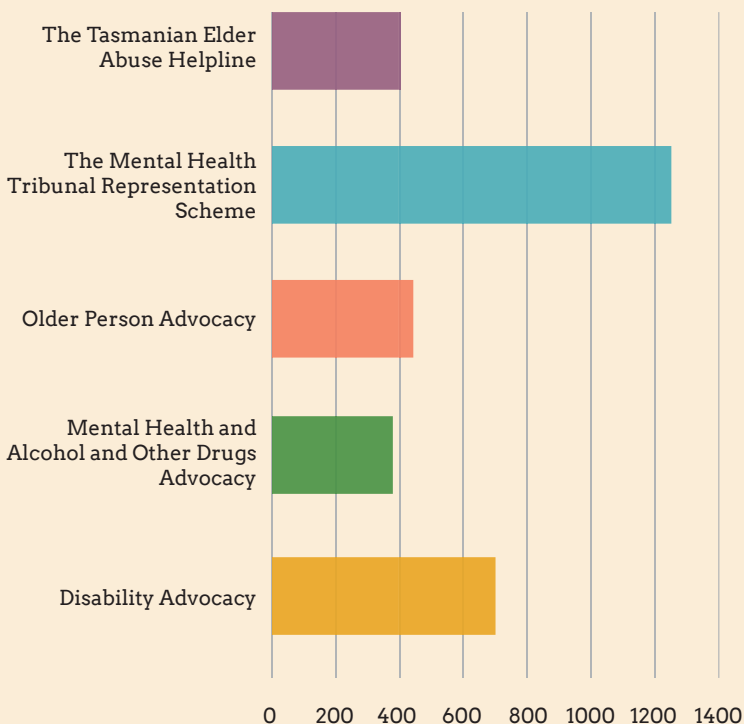

Reflections from the CEO

It is always a privilege towards the end of each year to have the opportunity to take a step back and reflect on the year past. This year has been one of both fulfilment and challenge for the whole team at AdvoTas. We have had the responsibility and privilege of supporting people to tell their stories to the Aged Care Royal Commission and we are busy preparing to do the same for the Disability Royal Commission.

We have also been hard at work increasing our regular presence across Tasmania, with a major focus on all aged care providers and mental health facilities. Over the year, the team undertook over 1,500 education sessions, which reached around 19,500 people across all of our program areas. We also worked with over 3,150 people through our individual programs, which is a real testament to the dedicated outreach and engagement efforts of everyone here at AdvoTas.

Alongside these efforts, we have been focusing on modernising and rejuvenating our constitution and governance structures, developing and launching a dedicated self-advocacy eLearning system, and undertaking a broad range of targeted human rights education initiatives. We have also been heavily involved with national and statewide strategies and networks to benefit our clients overall, such as the older persons advocacy network and the development of a new elder abuse prevention strategy for Tasmania.

I want to give a heartfelt thank you to the whole team at AdvoTas for their fantastic efforts and achievements over the last year. It has been my privilege to guide and lead you all through this period.

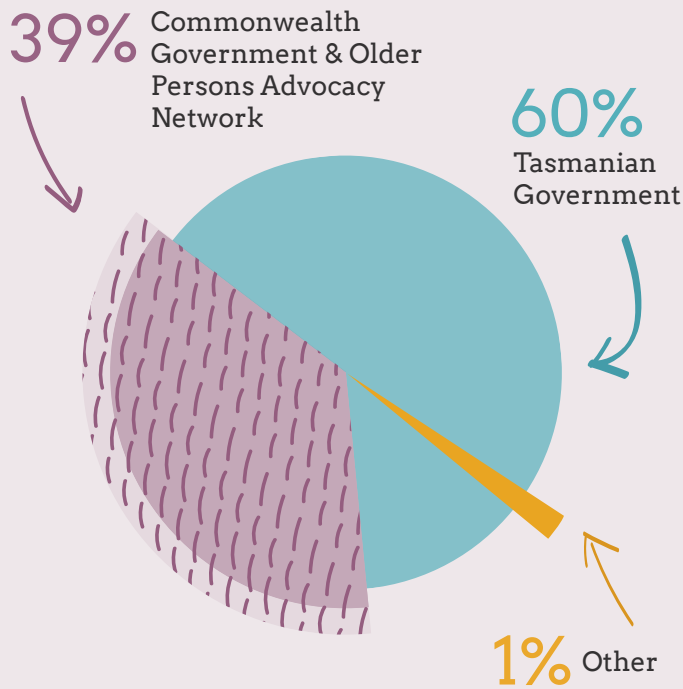

Financial Snapshot

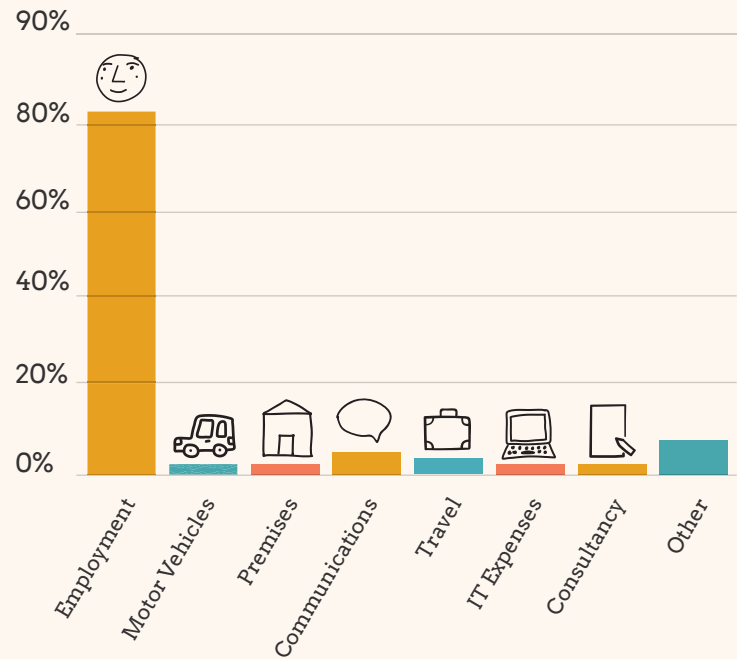
Where does our money come from?
